


1 SAMUEL 8:19-22NIV






















The king should be anointed by God

DEUTERONOMY 17:15A NIV

¹⁵be sure to appoint over you a king the Lord your God chooses.

GOD WANTED ISRAEL TO HAVE A KING, BUT OF HIS CHOOSING, AND AT HIS TIMING

SAUL WAS A PERFECT EXAMPLE OF A KING NOT FROM GOD'S WILL, WHO WAS CHOSEN BY THE NATION AND AT THEIR TIMING

DAVID IS AN EXAMPLE OF A KING CHOSEN BY GOD AND IN HIS TIMING.



The king should belong to God's people.

DEUTERONOMY 17:15B NIV

He must be from among your fellow Israelites. Do not place a foreigner over you, one who is not an Israelite.



The king should exercise faith

DEUTERONOMY 17:16NIV


16The king, moreover, must not acquire great numbers of horses for himself or make the people return to Egypt to get more of them, for the Lord has told you, "You are not to go back that way again."

THE FUTURE KING OF ISRAEL MUST NOT PUT UNDUE TRUST IN MILITARY MIGHT, HERE REPRESENTED BY HORSES THAT WERE MIGHTY WEAPONS IN A TIME WHEN MOST SOLDIERS FOUGHT ON FOOT.





The king should not put undue emphasis on physical indulgence or personal status





The king should be ready for sacrifice

DEUTERONOMY 17:17B NIV


He must not accumulate large amounts of silver and gold.

⁴ By justice a king gives a country stability, but those who are greedy for bribes tear it down.






The king should know the scriptures

DEUTERONOMY 17:18-19 NIV

¹⁸When he takes the throne of his kingdom, he is to write for himself on a scroll a copy of this law, taken from that of the Levitical priests. ¹⁹It is to be with him, and he is to read it all the days of his life so that he may learn to revere the Lord his God and follow carefully all the words of this law and these decrees.





The king should be an example of obedience and humility

DEUTERONOMY 17:20A NIV

²⁰and not consider himself better than his fellow Israelites and turn from the law to the right or to the left. EVERYONE NEEDS THE WORD OF GOD.
