

What does it mean that *God* is righteous?

God's righteousness means that He is perfectly just, holy, fair and right in all His actions and decisions. This attribute is central to His character and is consistently highlighted throughout the Bible.

WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE TO SEEK FIRST HIS *righteousness*?

→ I need to get serious about God and His <u>role</u> as righteous <u>Lord</u>. ¹⁸ And the Lord sent you on a mission and told you, 'Go and completely destroy the sinners, the Amalekites, until they are all dead.' ¹⁹Why haven't you obeyed the Lord? Why did you rush for the plunder and do what was evil in the Lord's sight?"

²⁰"But I did obey the Lord," Saul insisted. "I carried out the mission he gave me. I brought back King Agag, but I destroyed everyone else. ²¹Then my troops brought in the best of the sheep, goats, cattle, and plunder to sacrifice to the Lord your God in Gilgal."
