
# MAJORING ON THE WINCR

This is the message that the prophet Habakkuk received in a vision.

#### **HABAKKUK 1:2-4 NLT**

2 How long, O Lord, must I call for help?

But you do not listen! "Violence is everywhere!" I cry, but you do not come to save. 3 Must I forever see these evil deeds? Why must I watch all this misery? Wherever I look, I see destruction and violence. I am surrounded by people who love to argue and fight.

#### **HABAKKUK 1:2-4 NLT**

The law has become paralyzed, and there is no justice in the courts.

The wicked far outnumber the righteous, so that justice has become perverted.

### GOD'S ANSWER TO QUESTION 1:

TO DISCIPLINE MY PEOPLE.

#### HABAKKUK 1:6 NLT

6 I am raising up the Babylonians, a cruel and violent people.

They will march across the world and conquer other lands.

## QUESTION 2: HOW CAN A JUST GOD USE A NATION MORE WICKED THAN YOUR PEOPLE TO BRING JUDGMENT ON YOUR PEOPLE?

#### HABAKKUK 1:12-13 NLT

O Lord my God, my Holy One, you who are eternal—surely you do not plan to wipe us out? O Lord, our Rock, you have sent these Babylonians to correct us, to punish us for our many sins. 13 But you are pure and cannot stand the sight of evil. Will you wink at their treachery? Should you be silent while the wicked swallow up people more righteous than they?

### GOD'S ANSWER TO QUESTION 2:

BABYLON WILL BE PUNISHED IN GOD'S PERFECT TIMING AND FAITH WILL BE REWARDED.

#### **HABAKKUK 2:8A NLT**

8 Because you have plundered many nations, now all the survivors will plunder you.

#### **HABAKKUK 2:6A NLT**

"But soon their captives will taunt them.

They will mock them, saying, 'What sorrow awaits you thieves! Now you will get what you deserve!'"

#### **HABAKKUK 2:4 NLT**

"Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked. But the righteous will live by their faithfulness to God."

## WHAT WAS HABAKKUK'S RESPONSE TO GOD AFTER HIS QUESTIONS?

#### **HABAKKUK 3:1-2 NLT**

This prayer was sung by the prophet Habakkuk: 2 I have heard all about you, Lord. I am filled with awe by your amazing works. In this time of our deep need, help us again as you did in years gone by. And in your anger, remember your mercy.

#### HABAKKUK 3:17-19A NLT

17 Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vines; even though the olive crop fails, and the fields lie empty and barren; even though the flocks die in the fields, and the cattle barns are empty, 18 yet I will rejoice in the Lord! I will be joyful in the God of my salvation! 19 The Sovereign Lord is my strength! He makes me as surefooted as a deer, able to tread upon the heights.

#### **JOHN 5:17 NLT**

But Jesus replied, "My Father is always working, and so am I."

#### HABAKKUK'S ATTITUDE WAS CORRECT BECAUSE:

- 1. HE **ANTICIPATED** AN ANSWER FROM GOD.
- 2. HE WAS WILLING TO WAIT.
- 3. HE EXPECTED GOD TO CORRECT HIM.

HABAKKUK DIDN'T ASK GOD THESE QUESTIONS BECAUSE HE THOUGHT GOD WAS WRONG AND HAD TO EXPLAIN HIMSELF. HE ASKED THEM BECAUSE HE KNEW THAT HE WAS WRONG AND HE NEEDED TO BE CORRECTED.

## WHAT CAN WE GAIN FROM UNDERSTANDING THE BOOK OF HABAKKUK?

• TRUE FAITH LOOKS OUTSIDE OF SELF TO THE LORD GOD, WHILE PRIDE ALWAYS LOOKS TO SELF.

#### **HABAKKUK 2:4 NLT**

"Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked. But the righteous will live by their faithfulness to God."

#### **ROMANS 1:17 NIV**

For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."
